$$\textcircled{3} \quad \frac{2x}{3} + 5 = 6$$


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$$\frac{2x}{3} \rightarrow \frac{11}{1}$$

$$\frac{2x}{2} = \frac{33}{2}$$

$$x = 16.5 \text{ or } \frac{33}{2}$$

$$\textcircled{4} \quad 6x - 3 = -5x + 19$$


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$$11x + 3 = 19$$


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$$11x = 22$$


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$$x = 2$$

$$\textcircled{5} \quad \frac{(x+4)}{6} \rightarrow \frac{3}{1}$$

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$$x = 14$$
